


Annual Summary Report on Contract & Grant Expenditures

Fiscal Year 2002-03

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Overview¹

This Annual Report provides information on expenditures, both direct and indirect, associated with contracts and grants awarded to the University of California, Riverside (UCR) by non-University entities. These expenditures constitute charges assigned to the contract or grant in order to fully recover expenses incurred by UCR.

Direct expenditures are defined as costs that can be readily and specifically identified with benefiting a particular program or project. Examples include salaries and wages, employee benefits, supplies and equipment, etc.

Indirect expenditures are defined as costs that cannot be readily identified with a particular sponsored project. Examples include buildings (laboratories and offices), equipment, libraries, administrative services and clerical support.

Authorized expenditures, direct and indirect, against a contract and/or grant occur when a contract is fully executed or a written notice of a grant award has been received. The Principal Investigator is the primary person responsible for the financial management and control of project funds in accordance with the policies and procedures of UCR and the grantor.

Direct expenditures assigned to a contract or grant are 100% reimbursable by the granting entity. The reimbursements go directly to UCR. Indirect expenditures are reimbursed based on specific indirect cost rates established and applied to contracts and grants by the University of California.

Sources of extramural funds include federal/state/local agencies and private corporations, non-profit foundations and/or associations.

How Does the University of California Distribute Indirect Cost Revenue?

Indirect costs recovered from contracts and grants go to the UC Office of the President (UCOP). In turn, these monies are distributed to individual UC campuses in several steps.

<u>State Agencies</u>: Indirect cost reimbursements received from state agencies are retained by the UC Office of the President and are included in the General Funds of the UC System. Distributions to campuses are included in general fund allocations.

<u>Local Government/Private</u>: Indirect cost reimbursements received from local government and private donors/sponsors form the Education Fund of the UC System. The UC Office of the President retains a portion of these monies for targeted University-wide programs and distributes the remainder to UC campuses. The portion campuses receive is primarily based on how much indirect cost reimbursement each campus generates. Chancellors have discretion as to the use of these funds on each campus.

<u>Federal Government</u>: Indirect cost reimbursements received from federal agencies are allocated to UC campuses as Garamendi, Off-the-Top, Opportunity Funds and UC General Funds. Provided below is a table providing an overview of these funds:

	Garamendi
	Amount received by campus is based upon research occurring in specific campus buildings or facilities.
GARAMENDI	Funds are used for revenue bond repayment for acquisition, construction, renovation, equipping and maintaining designated research facilities.

How Does UCR Distribute Indirect Cost Revenue?

UC-Riverside distributes funds it receives from indirect cost recovery according to its policy stated in "A Policy for the Allocation of Federal and Private/Local Indirect Cost Recovery Funds," (updated October 2002). Section 1 – Growth in Contract and Grant Expenditures

Charts 1, 2, and 3 illustrate the growth in direct and indirect C&G expenditures over the past three fiscal years. In FY 2002-03, over half of all direct expenditures and over three-fourths of all indirect expenditures are associated with contracts and grants received from the Federal Government. Since FY 2000-01, direct and indirect expenditures in this fund group have each grown by 55%.

Charts 4, 5, and 6 illustrate changes in the generation of direct and indirect C&G expenditures among all fund groups between the campus schools/colleges and non-academic organizations over the past three fiscal years. The College of Natural and Agricultural Sciences generated more than one-half of all direct and indirect expenditures during the past three fiscal years. Expenditures generated by the Bourns College of Engineering have steadily increased to approximately one-fifth of all direct and indirect expenses.






Chart 2. Growth in Indirect C&G Expenditures FY 2000-01 to FY 2002-03






Chart 3. Growth in Direct and Indirect C&G Expenditures FY 2000-01 to FY 2002-03






Chart 4. Total Direct C&G Expenditures – All Fund Groups FY 2000-01 to FY 2002-03






Chart 5. Total Indirect C&G Expenditures – All Fund Groups FY 2000-01 to FY 2002-03





Chart 6. Total Direct & Indirect C&G Expenditures – All Fund Groups FY 2000-01 to FY 2002-03

Section 2 – Direct & Indirect Expenditures by Fund Source & Organization

Table 1 illustrates the growth rate for the past three fiscal years by fund source for the entire UCR campus. The percentage increase for the 3-year period is provided. Also included is the realized rate for each fiscal year. The realized rate is derived by dividing the indirect expenditures by the direct expenditures.

Tables 2 through 10 illustrate the growth rate for the past three fiscal years by fund source among the campus Schools/Colleges and non-academic organizations with contract and grant activity. These tables provide a breakdown of direct and indirect expenditures among fund sources for each fiscal year. The realized rate and percentage increase or decline over the past three years for each fund source is provided as well. Highlights from these tables include:

For most organizations, the majority of C&G expenditures are from contracts and grants received from the Federal Government. The exception is the Anderson Graduate School of Management.

Among the non-academic organizations included as "Other" in Table 10, C&G expenditures associated with State direct expenses are considerably higher than those from the Federal Government. Federal Government indirect expenditures are higher than the other fund sources however.

Among the Schools/Colleges, the realized rates for contract and grants received from the Federal Government were considerably higher than other fund sources. The exception was the School of Education, which had a realized rate for contracts and grants received from Private Agencies that was slightly higher than that realized from the Federal Government.

Over the past three fiscal years, Biomedical Sciences, BCOE, CNAS and VC-Student Affairs experienced a considerable increase in direct and indirect expenditures overall.

CHASS experienced a decline of 4% in indirect expenditures and the Graduate Division experienced a decrease of 14% in direct expenditures.

Over the past three fiscal years, the School of Education experienced a decline in direct and indirect expenditures of 16% and 2%, respectively. The Anderson Graduate School of Management experienced a decline in direct expenditures of 22% and 100% in indirect expenditures.

Section 3 – School/College Total C&G Expenditures All Fund Groups – FY 2002-03

Charts 6 through 8 provide a breakdown of total contract and grant expenditures for FY 2002-03 for the three colleges that have a departmental structure.

Within the Bourns College of Engineering (Chart 7), nearly one-half of all C&G expenditures were generated by CE-CERT. Computer Science & Engineering and the Center for Nanoscience and Engineering each generated 13% with Chemical and Environmental Engineering closely following at 12%.

Within the College of Humanities, Arts & Social Sciences (Chart 8), nearly one-third of all C&G expenditures were generated by Psychology. The Center for Bibliographic Studies and the Presley Center for Crime & Justice generated 21% and 15% respectively.

Within the College of Natural & Agricultural Sciences (Chart 9), the ratio of all C&G expenditures was spread out among its various departments. The three departments with the largest ratios were Entomology (18%), Botany & Plant Sciences (13%) and Chemistry (12%).






Chart 8. College of Humanities, Arts & Social Sciences





Chart 9. College of Natural & Agricultural Sciences
